This year's Drama Club, along with a few other students, had the All-School Variety Show. Here are just a few scenes from it. It was a very good program.

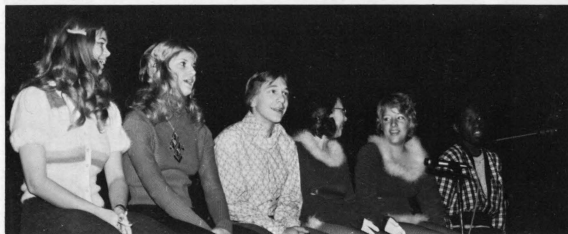


DRAMA
